



PACE OF PLAY → 4:10

Bramble Rules

Bramble with two best balls of four (80% handicaps)

Just like a scramble... Each player tees off. Select the best position and everyone plays within one club length of that location, however you must stay in the same condition (e.g. if you are in the rough, then you must stay in the rough).

Not like a scramble... Starting with your second shot, all players then play their own ball until holed out. The two lowest net scores count as your team score on each hole.

PACE OF PLAY: Since only two balls count, pickup if you cannot improve your team score.

If you have 3 players, then player #1 gets to hit an extra tee shot on hole #1. Player #2 on hole #2, player #3 on hole #3, then repeat. Only play three balls into the green. We will have a blind draw for your 4th player.

Check the pairings sheet for this week's closest to the pin.

If your name is listed first on the tee sheet, then you are the "**Team Captain**". You should pay the pro shop \$5 per player on your team, then collect the money from your partners. The Captain is responsible for the scorecard. Be sure to write all of the members of your team on the card and your tee time.

DO NOT POST scores in a Bramble because you are not always playing your own ball.
