



Two-Man Best Ball

Best net score of two (90% handicaps)

Each Player plays their own ball. 90% course handicaps are printed on the pairings sheet. Strokes are assigned to each player using the "handicap" holes on the scorecard. (Not sure what this means?.. Ask a pro)

Only the lowest (best ball) "net" score counts for your team. Write your team score relative to par at the top-right corner of the card and turn it in following your round.

PACE OF PLAY TIP! Once a player cannot improve the team's score, they should pick up and estimate what they would have scored for the hole and write that down.

Check the pairings sheet for this week's closest to the pin.

If your name is listed first on the tee sheet, then you are the "**Team Captain**". You should pay the pro shop \$5 per player on your team, then collect the money from your partners. The Captain is responsible for the scorecard. Be sure to write all of the members of your team on the card and <u>your tee time</u>. The Captain is also responsible for recording scores for teammates at the handicap computer following the round.
